Will the Minister of COOPERATION (सहकारिता मंत्री) be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the progress achieved in the implementation of White Revolution 2.0 and the outcome thereof including the status in Nabarangpur Lok Sabha Constituency;
- (b) the progress in the establishment of new Dairy Cooperative Societies and strengthening of existing societies under the initiative, State-wise including Karnataka, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh;
- (c) the measures taken to enhance milk procurement capacity in rural areas and to setup dairy infrastructure under the initiative;
- (d) whether any financial assistance has been released to States and implementing agencies for the initiative, if so, the details thereof including Odisha, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Punjab and Himachal Pradesh; and
- (e) the details of the funds sanctioned and released, the projects approved and their current operational progress, State-wise including Himachal Pradesh and Pali Lok Sabha Constituency of Rajasthan and Nabarangpur Lok Sabha Constituency?

- (a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (e) IN RESPECT OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 22 “WHITE REVOLUTION 2.0” ASKED BY SHRI BIBHU PRASAD TARAI AND SHRI KRIPANATH MALLAH, HON’BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT DUE FOR REPLY ON 21st JULY, 2026.

(a) to (b): (i): The Ministry of Cooperation has launched cooperative-led "White Revolution 2.0" to increase the milk procurement of dairy cooperatives by 50% from 660 Lakh Kilogram per day in 2023-24 to 1007 Lakh Kilogram per day by 2028-29 while promoting sustainable and circularity practices and also providing market access to dairy farmers in uncovered areas and increasing the share of dairy cooperatives in organised sector.

For this purpose, the Ministry of Cooperation has envisaged to set up 75,000 new Dairy Cooperative Societies (DCSs) in uncovered panchayats/villages and strengthen 46,422 existing DCSs. Till now, 24,097 new DCS have been formed and 31,394 existing DCS have been strengthened.

(iii): Target for Arunachal Pradesh were not envisaged in Margadarshika initially, however, from FY 2026–27, a target has been set to form 27 new cooperative societies in **Arunachal Pradesh**, out of which 25 societies have already been registered.

(iv): Nabarangpur district comes under KMNR (Koraput, Malkangiri, Nabrangpur and Rayagada) Milk Union which is affiliated Odisha Milk & Dairy Cooperative Federation (OMFED, Odisha). KMNR Milk Union operation area includes Koraput, Malkangiri, Nabrangpur and Rayagada districts. Under the White Revolution 2.0, the target vs achievement of KMNR Milk Union is as follows:

In Nabarangpur lok sabha constituency, 03 DCS were registered (02 in Nabarangpur and 01 in Malkangiri) in FY 2025-26.

(v): The outcome of the White Revolution 2.0 are as follows:-

a) In a span of 2 years, i.e FY 2024-25, FY 2025-26, 24,097 New Multipurpose Dairy Cooperative societies have been registered and further, 31,394 existing dairy cooperative societies have been strengthened providing market access to smallholder dairy farmers while ensuring fair and remunerative prices and expanding the network of primary dairy cooperatives and strengthening of the entire milk value chain including milk procurement, testing, chilling, logistics and processing infrastructure.

b) The milk procurement by cooperatives have increased from 660 LKG/day in 2023-24 to 697LKG/day in 2025-26

c) Milk production in India has increased to 247.9 Million Metric Tonnes in 2024-25 compared to 239.3 Million Metric Tonnes in 2023-24.

d) Two Multi-state cooperative Societies have been set up for promoting sustainability and circularity in dairy sector:-

- Gomay Sahkari Samiti Multi-State Limited (BGSSL) – for scientific manure management, including biogas and organic fertilisers.
- Cooperative Inputs and Services Delivery Multi-State Limited (NCISDL) – to ensure affordable access to input services such as feed, fodder, animal health, breeding, and technical support.

(c): To enhance milk procurement capacity in rural areas and to set up dairy infrastructure, the DAHD is implementing National Programme for Dairy Development.

Under Component A: Financial support is being provided for establishing and strengthening of DCSs under White Revolution 2.0.

Under component B, the following measures have been taken:

With respect to Strengthening Milk Procurement infrastructure, Milk processing & manufacturing facilities, Support for marketing & ICT infrastructure, Productivity enhancement, Training & capacity building, a total 42 projects were sanctioned to 36 Participation Institutions in 9 states (Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Punjab, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Uttarakhand) with outlay of Rs. 1588.53 Cr (Loan: 895.48 Cr, Grant Rs. 377.75 Cr and Participation Institutions' Contribution Rs. 315.30 Cr)

(d) to (e): The financial assistance to the States for the initiative are as under:-

In Pali Lok Sabha constituency of Rajasthan, under component 'B' of NPPD, ₹7.30 crore has been sanctioned and released for 90 village-level DCS formation and strengthening of existing DCS.

In Nabrangpur Lok Sabha constituency of Orissa, ₹37.2 lakhs has been released against the sanctioned fund of ₹74.4 lakh for forming 40 new DCS in the three districts Koraput, Malkangiri & Nabrangpur.
